Position Description

GCNYC is excited to recruit DEI leaders from various industries who have the availability and interest to lend their expertise in the launch of a new M.S. degree in Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Leadership. This program is focused on preparing graduates to successfully lead initiatives in DEI in the corporate, NGO, and government settings--domestically and internationally. GCNYC's model of a practitioner and activist professoriate brings the cutting edge of practice into the classroom.

The part-time Lecturer will play a collaborative role in the launch of the M.S. in DEI Leadership, working with the Program Director and other part-time Lecturers to design innovative courses.

The part-time Lecturer will collaboratively develop up to two 3-credit hours courses and will have the right of first refusal to teach one or both courses should they run in the coming calendar year. Courses will be taught online. Lecturers may elect to teach remotely or in person at GCNYC's campus in Manhattan.

Responsibilities

- Review and strengthen existing syllabi drafts to promote the approved curriculum's learning objectives.
- Develop online hybrid (synchronous and asynchronous) materials for up to two courses.
- Attendance at periodic program meetings.
- Consult on student recruitment activities, prospective industry partners, and program events.



Qualifications

- Master's or doctoral degree as well as relevant practice and/or research experience in diversity, equity, inclusion, belonging, social justice, education, organizational change, or related field.
- Experience and proficiency with Microsoft Office Suite, Google applications, and Zoom.
- Experience with providing engaging content in an online environment is preferred.
- Great communication, organization, and time management skills.
- Ability to work effectively and collaboratively in a remote environment with minimal supervision.
